Dear SCBCC and SCEA Commissioners:

The WPCC has completed an extensive review of the latest draft proposed Interlocal Agreement in our possession - the version delivered to BCC attorneys by OOCEA attorneys on 27 July 2010. We have marked up the document, click [here](#) to view, and feel quite strongly about the comments and recommended changes we made therein. While we appreciate prior changes made at our request, we firmly believe major provisions of the document still fall far short of responding to criticisms expressed in the letter of January 6, 2010, sent to the SCEA on our behalf by our attorney, Tom Feeney. We recognize and appreciate Commissioner Carey's courage in voting against adoption of the Interlocal presented being foisted on the BCC and SCEA by the OOCEA. We were shocked, dismayed, and disheartened, however, by the votes of Commissioners Dallari, McLean, Henley, and Van Der Weide, in favor of what we feel to be a gross betrayal of the rights of Seminole County citizens to home rule. We further see the approval votes as a serious abrogation of the duties and responsibilities of the office to which you were elected. From comments made during the meeting, it was clear that several of the Commissioners appeared they had not taken the time to thoroughly read and understand the document prior to the meeting. If this document is allowed to go forward without significant change, including bringing back in the requirement for a Seminole County full voting seat on the OOCEA, we are left with no alternative but to vigorously call public attention to what we see as an abdication of responsibility, as well as examining all

other options for redress.

We look forward to your responses in hopes that we may reach agreement on a document which does not sell out the voters of this County.
